Deputy Director-General and executive civil servant

Mr. Bernd Krämer is the Deputy Director-General of the German Military Aviation Authority (GMAA) and thus responsible for all aspects of safety in military aviation in the absence of the Director-General. At the same time, he also is the executive civil servant of the GMAA. In this position, he not only coordinates the various divisions, staff work and internal business affairs but also provides technical specialist leadership in these areas.

Mr. Krämer was born on 18 August 1956. He is married and has two children.

After successfully completing his second judicial state examination, he entered the Bundeswehr in 1988. Initially serving as an assistant section chief in the then Office of Defense Administration, Military District III (Düsseldorf), he took over the post of assistant section chief for logistic contractual affairs in the Air Force Support Command in the same year. In 1990, he was assigned to the Federal Ministry of Defense (FMoD) as an assistant branch chief. This was followed by a three-year assignment as assistant section chief in the Federal Chancellery where he was responsible for military law and defense budget issues from 1994.

Following his return to the Federal Ministry of Defense in 1997, Mr. Krämer held various posts as assistant branch chief and branch chief. Most recently, he acted as branch chief in the Directorate-General for Planning. In this function, which he performed from 2012 onwards, he was responsible for questions concerning the further development of civilian aspects of the Bundeswehr, scientific methods and innovation management, among other things.
