The Bundeswehr United Nations Training Centre (DEU UNTC) is a tactical-level, international, interagency facility for pre-deployment training.

OUR MISSION

The DEU UNTC conducts joint and interagency pre-deployment training for military and civilian personnel of the Bundeswehr and of partner nations and organisations.

OUR VISION

The DEU UNTC provides requirement-oriented hands-on training in close cooperation with NATO, the United Nations as well as national and international partners that is based on modern training technologies and agreed quality standards in order to prepare military and civilian personnel effectively for the missions of today and tomorrow.

WHAT WE DO

- Courses to qualify personnel as national and international military observers
- Interagency training support for NGOs, e.g. for the German Association for International Cooperation (Deutsche Gesellschaft für internationale Zusammenarbeit, GIZ) and the Center for International Peace Operations (Zentrum für Internationale Friedenseinsätze, ZIF)
- Hands-on English language training for operations in a multinational environment
- General military training for civilian Bundeswehr personnel
- Non-theatre-specific training (ELUSA) for headquarters and support personnel from the Joint Support and Enabling Service
- Special training courses on the use of modern surveillance technology
- Training in “corpse hygiene” for military personnel

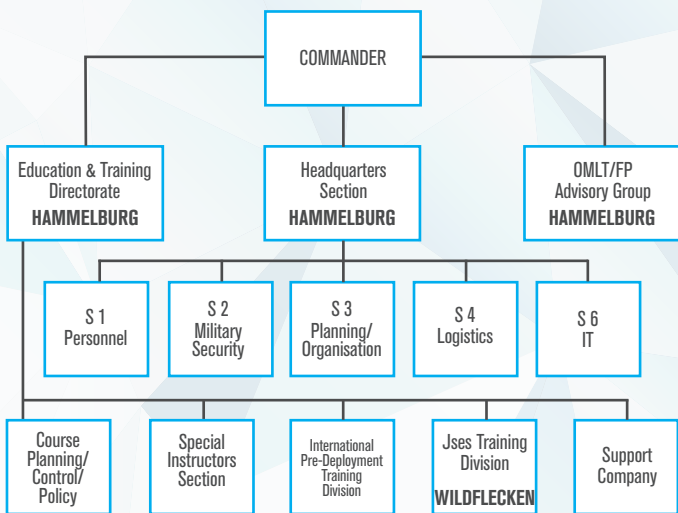
WHAT ELSE WE DO

The DEU UNTC also performs national duties as part of international UN and NATO committees.

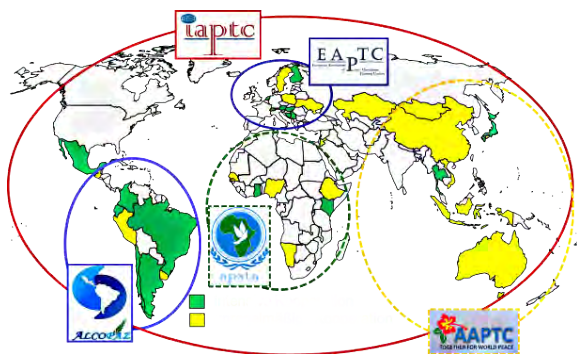
There is a constant exchange of experience with peacekeeping training centres or comparable training facilities of friendly nations around the world.

INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PEACEKEEPING TRAINING CENTRES (IAPTC)

The IAPTC is an open and voluntary association of centres, institutions and programs in the fields of education, training and development for peacekeeping operations.

The DEU UNTC is a full member of the IAPTC as well as of the regional network for peacekeeping in Europe, the European Association of Peacekeeping Training Centres (EAPTC).

In addition, the DEU UNTC has a permanent seat as an observer in the Asociación Latinoamericana de Centros de Entrenamiento para Operaciones de Paz (ALCOPAZ).

THE UNITED NATIONS

The DEU UNTC cooperates closely with the Department of Peace Operations. Thanks to this cooperation, our United Nations Military Observer Course (UNMOC) has already been certified several times. The DEU UNTC has also played a major role in updating and revising the current course contents.



NATO

As part of active quality assurance, the DEU UNTC complies with NATO's strict requirements. Since 2017, the Centre has been accredited as a NATO training facility. It thus belongs to a small circle of prominent institutions which have been given this seal of approval.

PARTNERS



NATO COMMITTEES

The Partnership Training and Education Centres (PTECs) are education and training facilities that conduct training courses, seminars and workshops for military and civilian personnel in accordance with the NATO guidelines' objectives and priorities. Since 2007, the DEU UNTC has co-chaired this committee.



TRAINING COOPERATION

Fo(u)r Peace Central Europe (4-PCE) is a joint cooperation platform of the national UN training centres in Germany, Austria, Switzerland and the Netherlands. It contributes to the harmonisation of training contents and conducts multinational exercises together.



CONDUCT INSIDE THE BARRACKS

We would like to draw your attention to the most important rules within the barracks.

We ask you to comply with all instructions designed to ensure military security and thus your personal security as well.

- You must present your ID card at the barracks gate.
- Taking photographs in the barracks area is strictly prohibited. Exceptions require prior approval.
- Entering other areas of the barracks, with the exception of the quarters assigned to you, the dining facility, the MWR facilities and the training rooms, is not permitted with no official purpose.
- Civilians must be accompanied by military personnel.
- The barracks is guarded by civilian/military personnel. Stay in the areas assigned to you.
- The guard personnel are authorised to check you and issue instructions at any time. Therefore, always carry your identification documents with you and follow the instructions.

PRIOR TO THE START OF TRAINING

SECURITY

Upon arrival, you will receive an access card in the guard building at the main entrance for the duration of your training. Please always carry your access card with you and keep it ready to be presented on request. The access card is needed to enter and re-enter the barracks.

Hot spots are set up in the MWR facilities and can be used free of charge.

DRESS CODE

The information package that you will receive with the welcome letter prior to the start of the course contains instructions on the dress code for each individual training course. You should also bring sports and civilian clothing for sports and off-duty activities.

PRIOR TO THE START OF TRAINING

QUARTERS

Bed linen is provided. You should bring your own towels, hair dryer and toiletries such as shampoo, etc. All rooms are equipped with a TV and a refrigerator.

POWER SUPPLY

The sockets in your rooms are standard household sockets. The voltage is 230 V. Please bring your own adapter if necessary.

TAP WATER

Tap water is freely available and has drinking water quality.

FOOD

Breakfast, lunch and dinner can be eaten in the dining hall of SAALECK Barracks.

On field training days, meals will be provided in the respective manoeuvre areas in the field.

PRIOR TO THE START OF TRAINING

MORALE, WELFARE AND RECREATION FACILITIES

If needed, you can buy food, coffee or take-away snacks at “Olly’s Landezone”, the central canteen.

The NCO club also offers à la carte breakfast, lunch and dinner against payment.

Advance booking is recommended for larger groups.

MORALE, WELFARE AND RECREATION FACILITIES

The MWR Office will provide you with information about off-duty activities. You can also rent bicycles, sports equipment, films and games.

Please bring indoor trainers.

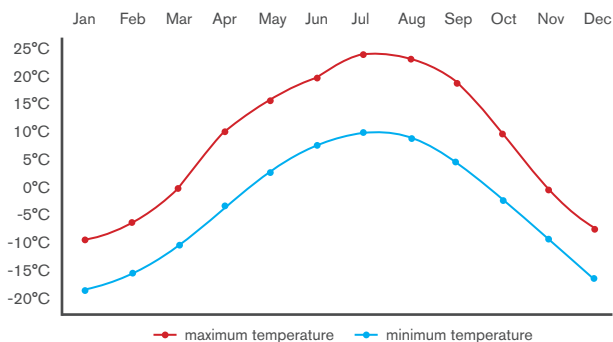


PRIOR TO THE START OF TRAINING

THE CLIMATE IN THE REGION

Temperatures in HAMMELBURG and WILDFLECKEN may vary considerably.

The attached chart is only a guide.



Please check current weather forecasts for your training period before you arrive and bring appropriate clothing.

RISK AREA FOR TICK-BORNE ENCEPHALITIS

According to the Robert Koch Institute, both HAMMELBURG and WILDFLECKEN are located in such an area.

Therefore, stay away from high vegetation if possible. Protect yourself, especially during training, by adapting your personal clothing.

If necessary, use a suitable insect repellent.
