





TRAINING



JCTC training follows a straightforward but effective principle. Building on the logistic experience acquired by our multinational training participants during training at home, JCTC training starts with imparting the fundamentals of NATO logistics. To this end, the JCTC curriculum among other offers includes various opportunities for training on the Logistics Functional Area Services (LOGFAS) logistic command, control and information system and a JLSG orientation course. Since 2019 JCTC is a NATO accredited education and training facility and the courses offered are NATO certified. The courses are followed by workshops/academics or small-scale exercises ("battle staff training") in which this knowledge is consolidated and enhanced. The highlight of the training effort is the exercises involving entire headquarters and including up to 120 participants, e.g. NATO certification exercises for JLSG HQs.
